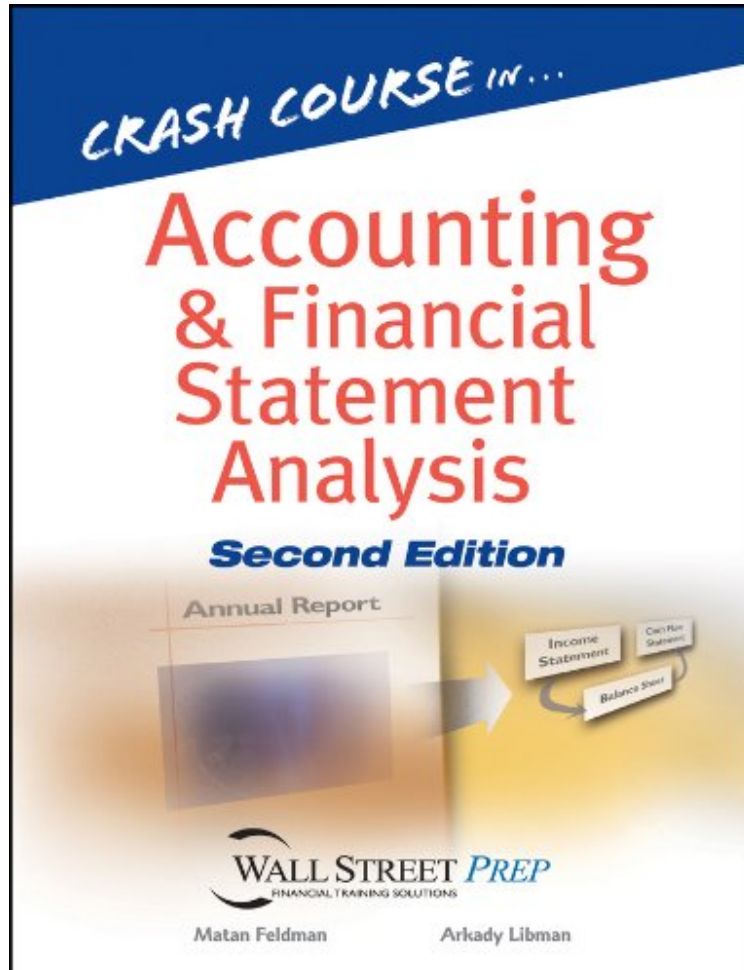

It does cover simple topics such as "If accounts receivable increased from one year to the next, then more people are paid on credit, which means a larger drain on cash" Seriously? This book is certainly tailored towards those who have had zero exposure. The ratio analysis section does nothing more than provide you with a simple definition, and the formula itself. There is ZERO information on analyzing changes to said ratios, to help you understand any net effect one change would have on the financials. To put it simply, if you know anything about accounting or financial statement analysis, this book is unfortunately not for you. I am not an accountant, with only 14 credits of accounting
